On April 30, 2007, Rockies Express Pipeline LLC (Rockies Express) filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) an application pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act and Part 157 of the Commission's regulations, requesting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing the construction and operation of an approximately 639-mile-long natural gas pipeline and related facilities, known as the REX-East Pipeline.
