ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On September 29, 2003, the Commission issued Certificate No. 03-068(1) to the village of Wellington (Wellington) to provide government aggregation services within Ohio. The expiration date for Certificate 03-068(1) was September 12, 2005. On August 3, 2005, the Commission issued a renewal, under Certificate 03-068(2). The expiration date for Certificate 03-068(2) was September 12, 2007.
- (2) The Commission's rules provide that a certificated governmental aggregator is required to file an application for renewal of its certificate at least 30 days prior to the expiration date of the current certificate. Rule 4901:1-27-09(A), Ohio Administrative Code.
- (3) On November 2, 2007, Wellington filed a motion for extension of the expiration date of its existing certificate. In the memorandum in support of its motion, Wellington states that it has determined that the public interest would be best served by not renewing the gas aggregation program. It requests extension of the certificate through December 31, 2007.
- (4) In order to allow Wellington to complete the termination of its gas aggregation activities, the examiner believes that an extension of the expiration date of Certificate 03-068(2), to December 31, 2007, is warranted. Therefore, the motion will be granted.

It is, therefore,

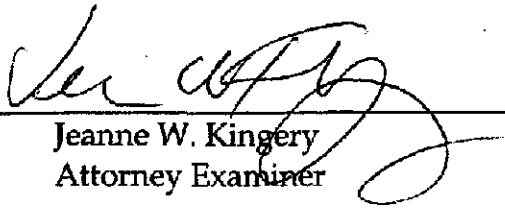
ORDERED, That Wellington's motion for an extension of its certificate's expiration date be granted. It is, further,
