The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) At the commencement of the hearing in these proceedings on April 10, 2007, the attorney examiners allowed portions of the testimony and exhibits to be placed under seal.
- (2) Having completed the hearing, the attorney examiner finds that there are portions of the sealed record that may not contain trade secret information and should not be considered or treated as confidential. Therefore, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., (Duke) should review and, by November 13, 2007, file a notice in the dockets of these cases as to which portions of the record it believes should still be treated as a trade secret and kept confidential pursuant to a protective order. 
than November 16, 2007. The attorney examiner will then make a determination regarding which portions of the record should be redacted and which should be filed in the public record.
