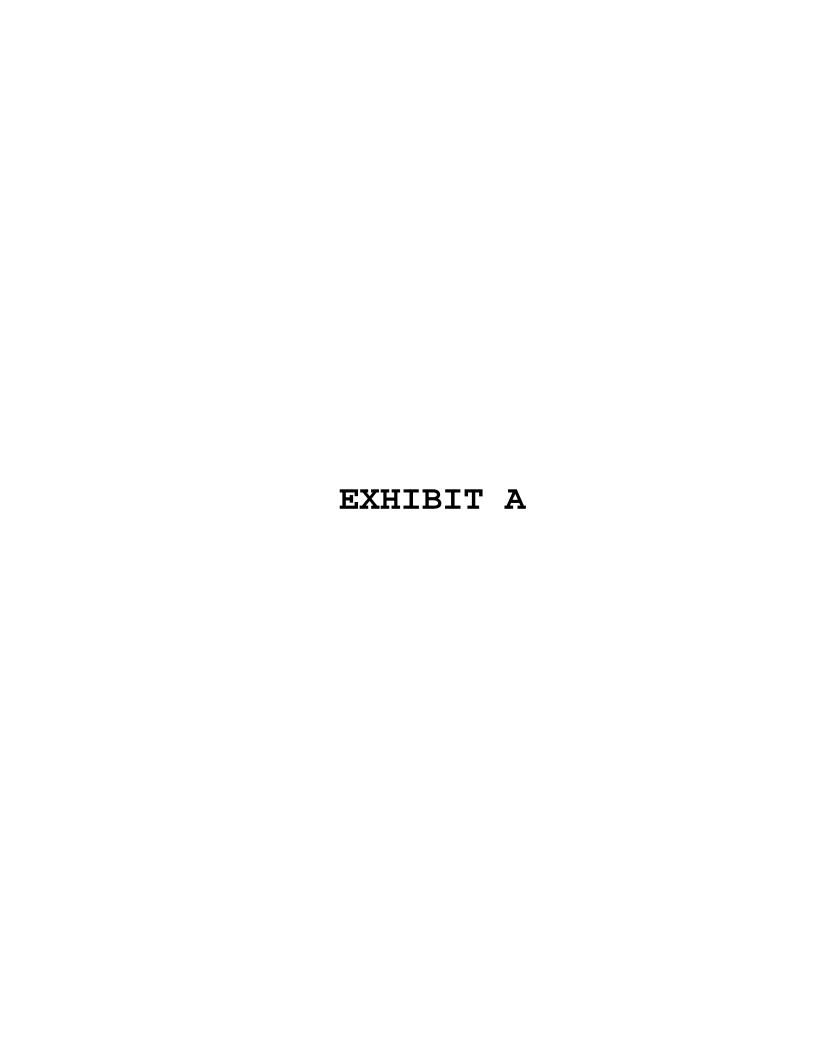



The Company will provide residence trunk lines which terminate in a PBX (or similar) system of (T) a college, university or other residence school (a) used solely by the students or student members described in 1-c, preceding, or (b) used by such college, university or other residence school for residence and administrative purposes, providing the non-residence and residence trunks are physically segregated so that the trunks classified as residence can only be accessed by the students or student members described in 1-c preceding. The Company reserves the (T) right to inspect the premises of the college, university or other residence school to assure compliance with the provisions of this paragraph, in accordance with Ownership and Use of Facilities, set forth in Part 2, Section 2 of this tariff.
