Cincinnati Bell Telecommunications Services, Inc. (CBTS), a subsidiary of Cincinnati Bell Inc., provides AOS services pursuant to CBTS Tariff PUCO No. 1. CBI transferred the assets of CBTS to BRCOM Inc, a separate CBI subsidiary. This filing revises CBTS Tariff PUCO No. 1 for this change in operations including changing the company name. Description and Rationale for Proposed Change and Customer Notice

Cincinnati Bell Telecommunications Services, Inc. (CBTS) is a payphone service provider that provides AOS services within Ohio pursuant to CBTS Tariff PUCO No. 1, which was effective March 23, 1999. This payphone service is marketed to customers using the name "Cincinnati Bell."

CBTS is a subsidiary of Cincinnati Bell, Inc. (CBI). CBI transferred the assets of CBTS to BRCOM Inc., another CBI subsidiary, in December 2006. This Application for Change in Operations (CIO) by an AOS/IOS provider is being made to change the name in the CBTS tariff to BRCOM Inc. (BRCOM), consistent with the asset transfer. This filing is in the public interest because it supports continued provision of payphone and AOS services within Ohio.

This name change will be transparent to users of BRCOM's services because service will continue to be marketed as "Cincinnati Bell." Furthermore, no rates, regulations, or services will change as a result of this filing. No customer notice is being provided because of the transient nature of the customers and because no changes will be apparent to users of BRCOM services.
