The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On September 6, 2007, Community ISP, Inc. (CISP) filed an application seeking authority to acquire the assets of Faster Processing, LLC (FP).
- (2) By attorney examiner entry issued October 4, 2007, the application was suspended for 60 days in accordance with Rule 4901:1-6-07, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), because additional information was needed to complete a review of the application.
- (3) As of November 30, 2007, staff informed the attorney examiner that CISP had not submitted all of the information needed by staff to complete its review of the application. Specifically, staff had requested that certain revisions be made to CISP's tariff prior to CISP's acquisition of FP's assets.
- (4) Given that CISP has not submitted all of the information needed by staff, the attorney examiner concludes that CISP's application must be suspended for a second time. Under Rule 4901:1-6-07, O.A.C., an application under a second suspension cannot be approved without a Commission entry or order.

ORDERED, That this application is suspended in accordance with finding (4). It is, further,
