To Whom It May Concern:

We are in receipt of the Ohio American Water letter dated October 12, 2007 stating a request for an additional increase in water rates for our Blendon residents. This would be the second rate increase this year for OAW. The Blendon Township Board of Trustees strongly objects to any more increases at the present time and with the current conditions of the water delivery system to our residents.

We objected in July of this year because the water was of inferior quality and the system needed to be much improved to bring it to an acceptable level. This is still a work in progress. Only when this job is completed to the residents' satisfaction should any rate increases be applied for.

We realize that Ohio American Water is a private utility, and as such is entitled to a fair and reasonable profit. However, it is unfair for the large corporation to place on the consumer the financial responsibility for making the water system capable of delivering a consistent, acceptable quality of water. The consumer should be entitled to quality water without the burden of the expense of past corporation mistakes. Merely bringing the infrastructure to an acceptable level should be part of the corporate investment in this system, not a burden of the consumers. Ohio American Water was fully aware of the condition of the delivery system and the necessary improvements when they bought the water company.
