Re: Boundary Change - Case No. 07-945-TP-ACB

On August 24, 2007, AT&T Ohio filed a letter of transmittal as contemplated by Rule 4901:1-3-03(G), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), to advise the Commission of a change in telephone boundaries involving two AT&T Ohio telephone exchanges. The revised maps filed by AT&T Ohio reflect the incorporation of a portion of AT&T Ohio's Hillcrest Exchange into the company's Cleveland Exchange in order to serve a new city hall on land owned by the City of Richmond Heights. AT&T Ohio explains that, today, the city receives telephone service out of the Cleveland Exchange. The new city hall is located on land contiguous to the existing city hall but would be physically located in the Hillcrest Exchange. Therefore, without this boundary change, the new city hall would have a different telephone prefix than all other city hall offices. AT&T Ohio avers that no customers will be adversely impacted by this change in telephone boundaries. In light of the foregoing and based upon the assertions made by AT&T Ohio in its August 24, 2007 transmittal letter, this matter should be considered approved pursuant to Rule 4901:1-3-03(M), O.A.C.
