I am so confused!

When I received the CD in the mail on app. November 26th concerning the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Rockies Express East Project, I was somewhat relieved to see that in section 3, page 41, the Shaffer Route Variations (MP 623.3 to 624.4).

It was taken into consideration my letter expressing my concerns about the impact of the pipeline construction within my property due to rolling topography that is very susceptible to landslides.

To avoid these impacts FERC identified a route variation that would be south of the project route and would avoid my forested and hilly areas of concern.

To get to the point,

I've repeatedly asked the Rockies Pipeline reps about placing the pipeline over across the street in the first place and each time I asked, I was told that FERC would not approve of it. To see the

Shaffer Route Variation on the disc really surprised me. I've been told all this time that it couldn't happen.

A Rockies East pipeline rep. was here yesterday December 03rd, 2007 along with two other men who said they were from the Environmental survey crew. I was advised they were here to conduct a study of my property before the installation of the new pipeline could begin. When I had informed them that I had a copy of your Environmental Impact Statement and it was advised that Rockies Express move the project a bit south (which is just across the street). I was told then, that they had no intention of deviating from the route as planned and they don't always accept the FERC's recommendations.

My question is: Who' has the final say so? FERC or Rockies? Please let all of us know, we the property owners along with the public whom write to you with our concerns.

It seems to me the Rockies Express employee's don't have yours or our, best interests at hand and when my land slides (and it will slide!) who's going to be here to clean up the mess and not at my expense, FERC or Rockies? Whose responsibility is it? It surely won't be mine!
