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1. CENTRAL OFFICE LOCAL AREA NETWORK SERVICE (C.O. LAN)

A. Description

Central Office Local Area Network (C.O. LAN) is a data communications network service providing for the interconnection of customer-provided data devices and for the transmission of data between such devices. C.O. LAN is provided from specially equipped Telephone Company central offices and utilizes data switching technology, digital and/or analog transmission facilities, and existing local facilities to provide switched data transport at speeds from 300 bps to 56 kbps.

The customer accesses the C.O. LAN by means of Data/Voice Multiplexers (DVM), private line service, or the public switched network via a modem pool arrangement. A customer-provided DVM is installed at the customer's premises providing connections for voice stations and data equipment while multiplexing their respective signals simultaneously to the Telephone Company central office (the customer-provided DVM must be compatible with the Telephone Company central office DVM). A DVM in the Telephone Company central office separates the signals, transmitting the voice to the exchange network and the data to the C.O. LAN. Data is transmitted through the C.O. LAN to a destination designated by the customer.

B. Definitions

Asynchronous Host Port - The Asynchronous Host port is the interface equipment, including a DVM and common equipment which permits the transmission of asynchronous data communications up to 19.2 kbps via exchange or private line facilities between the C.O. LAN data switch equipment in the Telephone Company central office and customer-provided data equipment, e.g., host computers.

Asynchronous Terminal Port - The Asynchronous Terminal Port is the interface equipment, including a DVM and common equipment, which permits the transmission of asynchronous data communications up to 19.2 kbps via exchange or private line facilities between the C.O. LAN data switch equipment in the Telephone Company central office and customer-provided data terminal equipment primarily designated as peripheral equipment, e.g., data terminals, personal computers, printers.

B. Definitions (Cont'd)

Data/Voice Multiplexer (DVM) - The DVM allows for the simultaneous transmission of both voice and data over an exchange or private line facility.

Dial In Modem - Arranged for incoming C.O. LAN data transmission via exchange type facilities. Each modem is considered a port and includes common equipment and interface equipment located in the Telephone Company central office. An exchange access line is required for each modem port.

Dial Out Modem - Arranged for outgoing C.O. LAN data transmission via exchange type facilities. Each modem is considered a port and includes common equipment and interface equipment located in the Telephone Company central office. An exchange access line is required for each modem port.

Modem Pool - A modem pool is one or more modems arranged in a group for a customer's use for either incoming or outgoing C.O. LAN data transmission via exchange type facilities. Each modem in a pool is considered a port. Modem pools are located in the Telephone Company central office. An exchange access line is required for each modem port.

Multiplexer Asynchronous Host Port - The Multiplexer Asynchronous Host Port is the interface equipment for each communication channel which permits the transmission of asynchronous data communication between the C.O. LAN data switch located in the Telephone Company central office and the multiplexer common equipment and customer-provided data equipment, e.g., host computers using speed configurations up to 19.2 kbps.

Multiplexer Synchronous Host Port - The Multiplexer Synchronous Host Port is the interface equipment for each communication channel which permits the transmission of synchronous data communication between the C.O. LAN data switch located in the Telephone Company central office and the multiplexer common equipment and customer-provided data equipment, e.g., host computers. A Multiplexer Synchronous Host Port can be provided in one of three speed configurations; up to 9.6 kbps, 19.2 kbps or 56 kbps.

Synchronous Host Port - The Synchronous Host Port is the interface equipment, including a DVM and common equipment which permits the transmission of synchronous data communications via exchange or private line facilities between the C.O. LAN data switch equipment in the Telephone Company central office and customer-provided data equipment, e.g., host computers. A Synchronous Host Port can be provided in one of three speed configurations; up to 9.6 kbps, 19.2 kbps or 56 kbps.

Synchronous Terminal Port - The Synchronous Terminal Port is the interface equipment, including a DVM and common equipment which permits the transmission of synchronous data communications via exchange or private line facilities between the C.O. LAN data switch equipment in the Telephone Company central office and customer-provided data terminal equipment primarily designated as peripheral equipment, e.g., data terminals, personal computers, printers. A Synchronous Terminal Port can be provided in one of three speed configurations; up to 9.6 kbps, 19.2 kbps or 56 kbps.

Trunk Module 56 Kbps Interface - The trunk module interface equipment includes a 56 kbps port and common equipment for each communications channel which permits the transmission of data communications between the C.O. LAN data switch equipment located in the Telephone Company central office and another Telephone Company C.O. LAN data switch or multiplexer common equipment.

Trunk Module 1.544 Interface - The Trunk module interface equipment includes a 1.544 mbps port and common equipment which permits the transmission of high-speed point-to-point data communications between the C.O. LAN data switch equipment located in the Telephone Company central office and another Telephone Company C.O. LAN data switch or multiplexer common equipment.

C. Regulations

1. C.O. LAN service can only be provided from central offices equipped for C.O. LAN services subject to the technical limitations of such equipment and availability of suitable facilities.
2. C.O. LAN service requires that the customer provide all DVM units located on their premises. The customer-provided equipment (CPE) must also be compatible with the Telephone Company provided DVM C.O. LAN services.
3. Modem pool members are dedicated to a specific customer for access by the customer's designees only.
4. The customer is responsible for the distribution of access codes, e.g., passwords to authorized users.
5. The standard network interface point must be located within the cable distance limitations of the multiplexer.
6. Each Terminal, Host and Modem Port requires an exchange or private line facility.
7. Termination charges for C.O. LAN Service will be subject to the following provisions:

If the combined number of ports and modems are reduced below the 80% level, the following options are available for the duration of the contract period.

- Continue to pay an amount equal to the monthly rates for 80% of the ports and modems contracted for at the Asynchronous Terminal Port Rate.
- Pay termination charges on the number of ports and modems below the 80% commitment which are disconnected at the Asynchronous Terminal Port Rate and continue to pay only for the number of ports and modems remaining in service. The termination charges will be determined using the following formula:

[ # of ports and modems below the 80% Level of Commitment  
disconnected ] x [ Asynchronous Terminal Port monthly rate ]  
x [ # of months remaining in contract ] x 50%

a. Simple and Complex Change Charge

Simple Change - A simple change charge will apply on a per port basis when the customer requests changes in various port options such as, Flow Control, Speeds, Parity Options, Destination, Hold and Attention Character.

Complex Change - A complex change charge will apply on a per port basis when the customer requests a port connection be moved from one exchange access line to another with no other change or port parameter.

Redesign of Data Base - A redesign of the data base will apply on a per system basis when the customer requests changes that will require the redesign of the system software for his system. System software changes that would require a redesign of the data base are any one and/or all of the following: Names, Group Names, Network Access Passwords, Security Patterns, Service Names, Receiving Groups, Originating Groups, 2-way Groups, Trunk Groups and Hardware Modules. Such redesign of the data base will be furnished at charges based upon expense incurred.
