Dear Commission.

This letter is in response to the recently published Draft Environmental Impact Statement on the above stated project. As landowners we are impacted by this purposed project, and in Sec. 3.5.13 are referred to in regards to the Jones and Mowrey Route Variation (MP 458.1 to MP 458.9). We appreciate the commission's review of this route and agree with its recommend route variation. This recommendation will preserve the Wilson Friendly Farm maple syrup operation and will impact less forested area. In addition placing the route along property boundaries preserves the integrity of existing structures and property to some extent.

To date Rockies Express has shown no interest in pursuing FERC'S recommendation. Should Rockies choose to ignore FERC'S recommendation a detailed explanation of why is in order. As it has been proven time and time again in this project Rockies has no respect for the landowner so FERC is our only venue for requiring Rockies to use the proposed recommendation. To make such recommendations without requiring compliance is of no value.

In addition FERC has recommended in section 4.3.4 that no construction begin between MP 432.9 to MP 467.2, until the purposed HDD is successfully completed at the purposed Little Miami River crossing. We strongly agree with this recommendation and once again will rely on FERC to enforce such measures so no environmental resources are destroyed needlessly.

It is our hope that these recommendations are simply not appeasement tools used by big business and government to placate the landowner. These variations need to be taken seriously by Rockies and enforced by FERC. FERC is the only resource available to the landowner to have input into such purposed projects and we as taxpayers have to rely on FERC to make our voice heard.
