ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On October 24, 2007, the Commission issued its order on remand in the above-captioned cases. In part, the order on remand directed Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) to prepare a redacted version of certain confidential exhibits and file that redacted version within 45 days of the date of the order on remand. The order on remand also directed that any other party file redactions of any sealed documents it filed with the Commission no later than 60 days after the date of the order on remand.
- (2) On December 7, 2007, Duke filed its version of the redacted exhibits.

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- (3) On December 13, 2007, the Office of the Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed a motion for an extension of time until January 23, 2008, for all parties to file their versions of their redacted exhibits, which are currently due on December 24, 2007. OCC indicated that it needs an extension of time to perform redactions to the confidential exhibits it filed in these proceedings and to review the exhibits filed by Duke. OCC stated that, in light of the expedited schedule for the filing of pleadings and responses established by the attorney examiners in these proceedings (motions must be served electronically and memoranda contra are due in seven days after the filing of motions), it notified electronically all parties on December 11, 2007, of its request. In its motion, OCC indicated that Duke, Dominion Retail, Inc., Ohio Marketers' Group, Ohio Hospital Association, and People Working Cooperatively did not oppose OCC's request. No memoranda contra to OCC's motion have been filed.
- (4) Upon review, the attorney examiner finds that there is good cause to grant OCC's motion to extend the deadline to January 23, 2008, for all parties to file redacted versions of all documents such parties filed with the Commission.


It is, therefore,
