The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On November 20, 2007, Duke Energy Ohio (Duke) filed an application for approval of a new bill format.
- (2) On December 20, 2007, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel filed a motion to intervene in this case.
- (3) Pursuant to Rules 4901:1-10-33(F), and 4901:1-10-22(C), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), an application for approval of a new bill format becomes effective after 45 days unless the Commission specifically orders otherwise.
- (4) As this application will be approved on January 4, 2008, unless suspended, and in light of the fact that a motion to intervene has been filed and the time for filing memorandum contra has not yet lapsed, and because the Commission staff requires additional time to review the application, automatic approval of the application should be suspended.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That approval of Duke's application is suspended until the Commission specifically orders otherwise. It is, further,

 ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon Duke and their counsel and all other interested persons of record in this matter.
