ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc., (VEDO) is a natural gas company as defined in Section 4905.03(A)(6), Revised Code, and a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Sections 4905.04, 4905.05, and 4905.06, Revised Code.
- (2) Section 4929.04, Revised Code, permits a natural gas company to request an exemption from certain provisions of Chapters 4905, 4909, and 4935, Revised Code, governing the company's commodity sales services and ancillary services.
- (3) On December 21, 2007, VEDO filed an application pursuant to Section 4929.04, Revised Code, for approval of a general exemption of certain natural gas commodity sales services or ancillary services contained in Chapters 4905, 4909, 4935, Revised Code. In addition, VEDO requests approval of a proposed exit transition cost rider pursuant to Section 4929.11, Revised Code. Along with its application, VEDO filed a motion requesting, *inter alia*, that the Commission establish a procedural schedule in this case, including a prehearing conference and technical conference.
- (4) Paragraph (B) of Rule 4901:1-19-09, Ohio Administrative Code, authorizes the attorney examiner to schedule a technical conference to discuss the application.
- (5) Accordingly, the attorney finds that a prehearing, technical conference should be scheduled in this matter on Monday, January 28, 2008, at 1:30 p.m., at the offices of the Commission,


