## The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc., (VEDO) is a natural gas company as defined in Section 4905.03(A)(6), Revised Code, and a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code. As such, VEDO is subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission in accordance with Sections 4905.04 and 4905.05, Revised Code.
- (2) On September 28, 2007, VEDO filed notice of its intent to file with the Commission an application for approval of an increase in gas rates and an application for approval of an alternative rate plan. On November 20, 2007, VEDO filed its application for approval of an increase in gas rates and application for approval of an alternative rate plan.
- (3) As part of its notice filing, VEDO filed a motion requesting that the Commission schedule a technical conference to discuss and consider the issues raised in its proposal for an alternative rate plan.

(4) Accordingly, a technical conference should be scheduled to allow interested persons the opportunity to better understand VEDO's proposed alternative rate plan. The conference will be held on February 4, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio.
