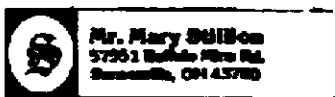
Docket # CP07-208. We believe this project proposed by REX provides extreme danger to the residents of Guemsey. The combination of the high voltage towers and the gas alone is enough but add to that the sink holes from the old coal mines creating an even greater chance of an explosion. We are purposing a different route East of the pumping station in McConnellsville lie the Ohio Power lands that have been stripped of coal and with no population. Rerouting the pipe line there would keep it out of this area of Guemsey County. We also feel with such "cheap" pipe with high toxic covering to prevent corrosion it should be buried 7 to 10 feet instead of the 60" the Ohio Farm Bureau has negotiated.
