ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On July 24, 2007, Nancy Robinson filed a complaint against Dayton Power & Light Company (DP&L). In the complaint, the Complainant alleged that DP&L failed to properly credit a deposit to her account and charged her a second deposit.
- (2) On August 10, 2007, DP&L filed its answer, in which it generally denied the allegations of the complaint, a motion to dismiss, and a request for mediation.
- (3) Accordingly, a prehearing conference should be scheduled for March 17, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, Hearing Room 11-B, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (4) The purpose of the prehearing conference is to explore the parties' willingness to negotiate a resolution of this complaint in lieu of an evidentiary hearing. An attorney examiner from the Commission's legal department will facilitate the settlement process; however, nothing prohibits any party from initiating settlement negotiations prior to the scheduled conference. The parties should bring to the conference all documents relevant to this matter.

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


