I AM RICHARD KEMP AND I AM A LANDOWNER AND BY THE RIGHT OF EMINENT DOMAIN I HAVE NO CHOICE IN WHERE THE EAST PIPELINE GOES. WHY CAN'T I REQUEST IT BE MOVED ON MY PROPERTY APPROXIMATELY 300 FEET SINCE THERE IS A CURVE IN THE PROPOSED LINE THIS WOULD BE LESS DISTANCE AND MISS MY HAY FIELD AND FUTURE BUILDING SITES. THE ORIGINAL REX PIPE LINE WOULD BE BETTER THAN THE PROPOSED ALTERNATE ROUTE AROUND SLOPE CREEK RESERVOIR. BECAUSE IT IS 2000 FEET SHORTER, IT WOULD EFFECT LESS PROPERTY OWNERS AND WOULD BE EASIER TO INSTALL RESULTING IN LESSER INSTALLATION COSTS. IT WOULD RUN PARALLEL WITH A HIGH VOLTAGE LINE THAT WOULDN'T INTERRUPT WITH FARMING. THE REX PIPE LINE GOES UNDER THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER, THE WABASH RIVER, AND SEVERAL OTHER LAKES AND RESERVOIRS.
