The attorney examiner finds:

- (1)On April 16, 2007, the Ohio Edison Company, Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, Toledo Edison Company and American Transmission Systems, Inc. (Companies) filed a motion for a protective order regarding their 2007 electric longterm forecast report (LTFR). In support of their motion, the Companies state that certain portions of Chapters 3 and 4 relating to their transmission and distribution systems contain operationally sensitive and propriety information and locations of electrical facilities. The Companies assert that the information submitted under seal details the characteristics of transmission owner's existing transmission and lines substations and also shows the interrelationship of facilities by listing the interconnecting lines and substations as well as lineloading limits. The Companies believe that this information should be considered critical energy infrastructure information and kept confidential.
- (2) Upon review of the Companies' motion, the attorney examiner finds that, pursuant to Rule 4901-1-24(D), Ohio Administrative Códe, the Companies' motion for a protective order should be granted and directs that the portions of the Companies' 2007 LTFR filed under seal remain under seal until otherwise ordered by the Commission.
