

1.1 Application of the Tariff

1.1.1 The Company's service territory is the State of Ohio.

1.2 Undertaking of the Company

1.2.1 To the extent provided herein, the Company undertakes to furnish communications services to business customers pursuant to the terms of this tariff in connection with one-way and two-way information transmission between points in the State of Ohio.

The Company provides Data Transport Service to Customers offered on a point-to-point basis. Each Private line Service is dedicated to the Customer and the entire usable bandwidth for each service is available to the Customer for their exclusive use.

1.3.2 Transport Services

The Company offers dedicated transport over copper mediums. The Company may offer Transport Services at a variety of speeds in geographic areas where the Company's facilities are available, or where such services are available through other Carriers facilities at the Company's sole discretion.

Code 4901:1-5-03, which is entitled "Telephone Customer Rights and Responsibilities." These rights and responsibilities include complaint handling, ordering or changing service, service repair, payment of bills, and disconnection and reconnection of service.
