4. The transaction contemplated by the Agreement will serve the public interest. PNG is a strong company that will continue to provide high quality services to Global Touch's

customers. The purchased customers not only will continue to receive the same services they currently purchase from Global Touch but also will have access to additional and enhanced products and services offered by PNG.

The proposed transfer does not present any competitive issues. There are a number of other carriers operating in each market, including the incumbent carrier, which controls a substantial market share. Further, PNG has extensive experience offering interexchange telecommunications services. Consequently, the former Global Touch customers will continue to receive these services from an experienced and qualified carrier. These customers also will be given sufficient notification of the proposed transaction and their rights. As such, the Parties anticipate that customers will experience a seamless transition of service provider.
