Message Rate Local Exchange Service lines are provided for the connection of Customer-provided wiring, telephone, facsimile machines or other station equipment. Local exchange service lines and trunks are provided on a single party (individual) basis only. No multi-party lines are provided.

Recurring charges for Message Rate Local Exchange Service are billed monthly in advance. Non-recurring charges for installation or rearrangement of service are billed on the next month's bill immediately following work performed by the Company.

All service is available on a term commitment basis only.

Customers may choose a Local Call Pack for usage. If the Customer does not choose a Local Call Pack, local usage will be billed on a per message basis as noted below.

Toll Free, Calling Card and International calling are not included in the toll calling portion of this plan, but are available at tariffed rates.


