The Comments of the Ohio Power Siting Board, a 54-page document, was posted on the FERC web site, January 14, 2008. Docket #CP07-208 The filing was posted by the Ohio Public Utilities Commission, reference accession number 20080114-5061.

This is further evidence that FERC does not care anything about the project other than getting the approval for REX.
