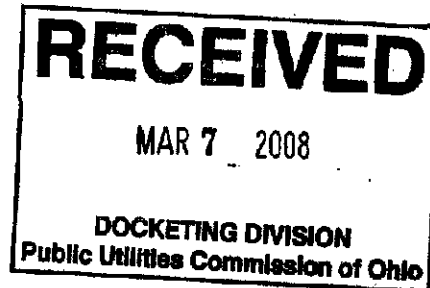

Ladies and Gentlemen:

On April 30, 2007, at Docket No. CP07-208-000, Rockies Express Pipeline LLC ("Rockies Express") filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") for authorization to construct and operate certain facilities known as the "REX-East Project." Thereafter, on January 25, 2008 at Docket No. CP07-208-001, Rockies Express filed an amendment to its application to provide formal notice of the intent of Rockies Express to (1) move the location of its proposed Hamilton Compressor Station; and (2) realign the pipeline for 3.9 miles to adjust for the move.

By letter dated February 27, 2008, Rockies Express received a data request from Mr. Jack Donaho, Team Leader, Certificate Branch 1, Office of Energy Projects, requesting that Rockies Express provide certain additional information in order to assist Staff in its analysis of the application ("February 27 Data Requests"). Rockies Express was directed to file its responses, under oath by an authorized company representative, within 15 days of the date of the letter.

Attached hereto are the responses of Rockies Express to the February 27 Data Requests. Rockies Express has organized its responses into appendices described below pursuant to the Commission's Critical Energy Infrastructure Information ("CEII") filing guidelines:

Responses to Data Request dated February 27, 2008

1. In its January 25, 2008 Amendment, Rockies Express proposes to move the location of its Hamilton Compressor Station from Butler County, Ohio to a new location in Warren County, Ohio known as the "Bern site".

Supplement Rockies Express' original Exhibit G and G-I submitted in its application by providing new flow diagrams to reflect the change in location of the Hamilton Compressor Station. As part of Rockies Express' response, provide all data sets for the hydraulic studies used to support the new flow diagrams. Submit all data sets in electronic format on CD or DVD. Please provide copies of the hard copy and the CD-ROM directly to Joseph Caramanica in Room 61-57.

Response to 1:

Attached as Appendix 2 are new flow diagrams reflecting the change in location for the Hamilton Compressor Station, including a hard copy and computer disc of the input and output files (hydraulic studies) utilized to model the new flow diagrams. The flow diagrams supplement Rockies Express' original Exhibit G/G-I filed April 30, 2007 at Docket No. CP07-208-000. As indicated in the letter of transmittal, one hard copy of the complete filing and a compact disc containing the input and output files utilized to model the flow diagrams is being hand delivered to Joseph Caramanica, FERC Staff, Room 61-57.

The information in this response contains commercially sensitive, proprietary information. Rockies Express, therefore, requests that the information be treated as privileged and confidential under the Commission's regulations. Additionally, the information contains Critical Energy Infrastructure Information ("CEII"). 2. Provide updated information showing the acreage and number of parcels, both temporary and permanent, required for the project. Show the percentages for which Rockies Express has obtained easements and for which Rockies Express expects to gain easements. Discuss the extent to which Rockies Express anticipates the need to rely on eminent domain to obtain easements. If you believe no condemnation will be required, provide justification for that belief.

Response to 2:

The table on the following page reflects the acreage and number of parcels, both temporary and permanent, required for constructing the pipeline facilities for the REX-East Project. Based on these requirements, the table shows the current percentages of easements that Rockies Express already has obtained and expects to obtain in the future. This chart is a snapshot of the current land acquisition process. Rockies Express has successfully negotiated with approximately 56% of the landowners for the REX-East Project and is in the process of negotiating with the majority of the remaining landowners along the right-of-way. Rockies Express expects to have a successful resolution of this process. To the extent necessary, and only as a last resort, Rockies Express will utilize condemnation and applicable eminent domain procedures where negotiations with landowners are not successful.
