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To Whom It May Concern:

I am the sole proprietor of the Hunt-Forman Farm which is listed in the National Registry of Historic Places under Hunt-Forman Farm Warren County Ohio - #04000607. Because my historical farm is directly in the path of the Rockies Express pipeline, I am explicitly requesting to be a participating consulting party in the Section 106 process of the NHPA in accordance with C.F.R. 800.2 (C) (5) and 800.3 (f) (3). I wish to emphasize that Section 106 of the NHPA and the NEPA process are two distinct procedural requirements and that it is important in this under taking for Section 106 to inform the decisions being made in the NEPA process. "Consultation" is a critical component of the Section 106 process and the "goal of consultation is to identify historic properties potentially affected by the undertaking, assess its effects and seek ways to avoid, minimize or mitigate any adverse effects on historic properties." 36 CFR 800.1 (a). My property is the only NRHP listed historic property in the entire six state proposed pipeline r.o.w. path. Furthermore, the Hunt-Forman Farm is one of the few remaining original family farms located within the area of expanding urban development between Cincinnati and Dayton. The farm has architectural significance for its historic buildings, cultural/agrarian significance as a farm where the Poland China breed of swine was developed. The farm is a unique surviving example of historic vernacular agricultural landscape. REX's proposed pipeline will have significant adverse effects on the integrity of my NRHP listed property. Avoidance, by reroute is highly recommended. See attached reroute map.

Again, my property is the only listed NRHP property in the pipeline path in the entire eastern phase of the Rockies Express project. Also, who is the FERC Agency official responsible for Section 106 compliance per 800.2 (a)?

Lastly, your timely response to these two requests is appreciated.

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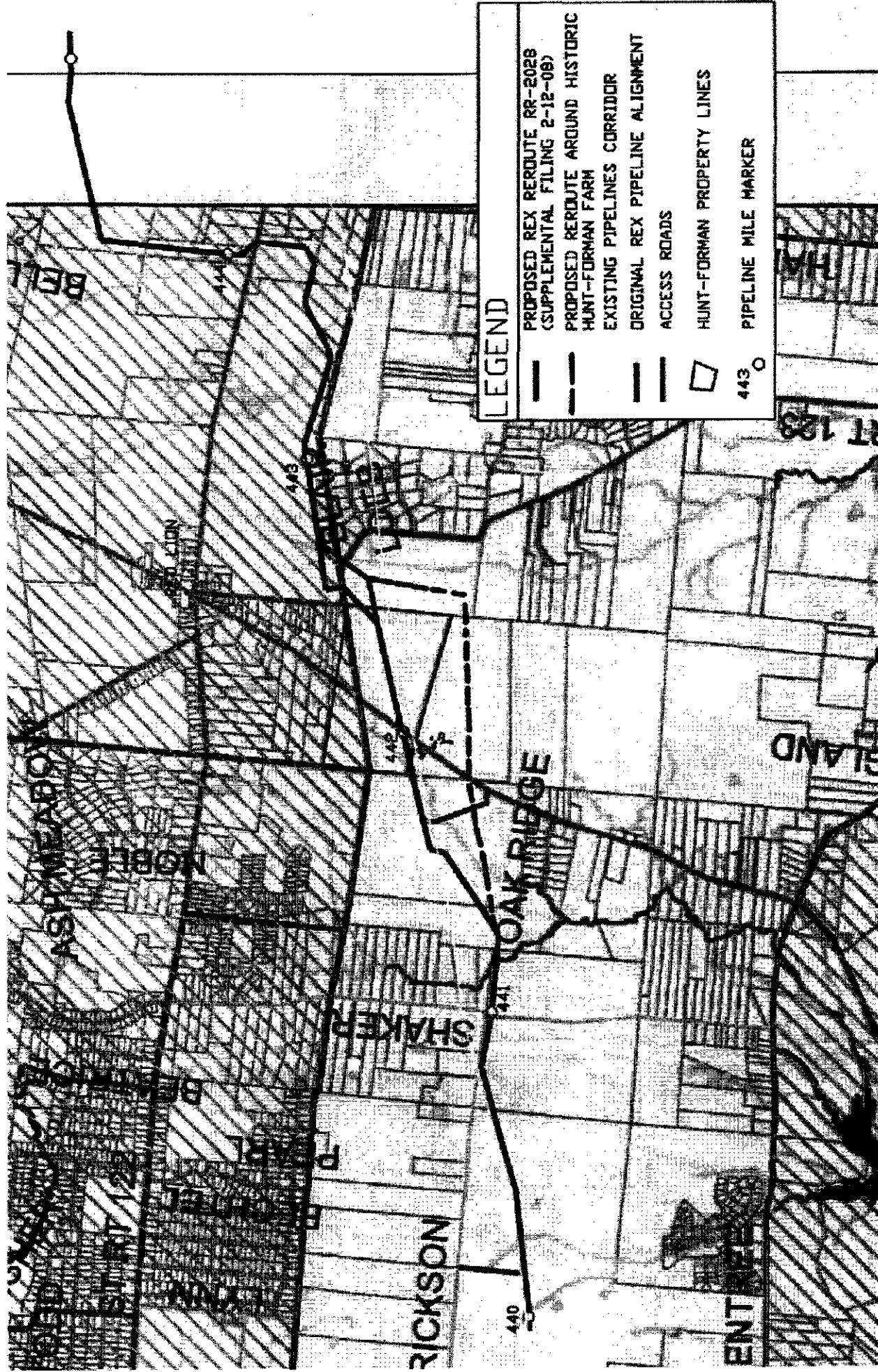
