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P.U.C.O. NO. 5 General Exchange Tariffs

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P.U.C.O. NO. 5

LOCAL EXCHANGE TARIFF MINFORD-STOCKDALE EXCHANGE RATES

Customers have certain rights and responsibilities under the Minimum Telephone Service Standards (Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-5) (the "MTSS"). These safeguards can be found in the Appendix to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-5-03, which is entitled "Telephone Customer Rights and Responsibilities." These (T) rights and responsibilities include complaint handling, ordering or changing service, service repair, payment of bills, and disconnection and reconnection of service.

A. Service Offerings.

1. The rates below entitle subscribers in the Minford-Stockdale Exchange and in the Clarktown* and Rubyville* areas of Verizon North Inc.'s Portsmouth Exchange to make local calls (i.e., without additional toll charges) to others in the Minford-Stockdale Exchange and anywhere in the Portsmouth Exchange. Calls to South Shore, Kentucky, are toll calls.

*Service will be available where facilities exist.

2. The rates, terms, and conditions for all services provided to subscribers in the Clarktown and (N) Rubyville areas of Verizon North Inc.'s Portsmouth Exchange will be identical to those provided to subscribers in the Minford-Stockdale Exchange.

B. Membership Fee.

1. There shall be a non-refundable fee of \$15.00 charged each member, to be paid prior to connection of service.

2. Membership standing shall remain in full force and effect unless and until the member terminates his service or is suspended by the Board of Trustees for non-payment of any amounts due for local service within 5 working days of date due.

3. No second membership fee will be charged a former member who re-applies for service within one year of his prior termination of membership.

4. All subscribers must be members of the Minford Telephone Company.

ACCESS SERVICE TARIFF P.U.C.O. No. 1

1. Intrastate Carrier Access Service

- A. This Company, hereinafter called the concurring company, assents to, adopts and concurs in the regulations, rates and charges for the provision of intrastate Carrier Access Service as specified in the Access Service Tariff, F.C.C. No. 5 filed with the Federal Communications Commission by the National Exchange Carrier Association as such tariff now exists, or as it may be revised, added to or supplemented by superseding sheets or issues; provided however, that the regulations, rates and charges specified in Section 4, End User Access Service, have been excluded from intrastate customers by order of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. The rates, terms, and conditions for Intrastate Carrier Common Line Access Service are set forth herein.
- B. Sections of the Access Service Tariff, F.C.C. No. 5, to be concurred in are as follows:

C. Interexchange billing and collection services, except for recording services, are deregulated. Recording services, other than billing name and address services, while subject to regulation by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, are detariffed effective January 1, 1988. Upon conversion of an end office to equal access, billing name and address information for nonpresubscribed traffic shall be provided to interexchange carriers upon rates, terms and conditions to be filed with this Commission.

D. Access Rates for Out of Territory Operations

In accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-7-14(D), the switched access rates Minford will charge for originating and terminating traffic in the Clarktown and Rubyville areas of Verizon North Inc.'s Portsmouth Exchange will be capped at National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) access rates. Minford is a rural ILEC competing with a nonrural ILEC in a rural area.
