#### PREFERRED ALIGNMENT OF REX PIPELINE

### LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The following description defines the south Right-of-Way line for the South East Beltway. The preferred pipeline alignment is centered on a line offset twenty-five feet to the south of the following description:
