# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE EBER-SWANTON 138 kV TRANSMISSION LINE RELOCATION FOR THE HALLETT ROAD RAILROAD RE-ALIGNMENT PROJECT

The following information is being provided in accordance with the procedures delineated in Ohio Administrative Code Section 4906-11-02: <u>Construction Notice Requirements</u> of the Rules and Regulations of the Ohio Power Siting Board.

# 4906-11-02 (A): Information Requirements

# 4906-11-02 (A) (1): Name of the Project

Name of Project:Eber-Swanton 138 kV Transmission Line Relocation for the<br/>Hallett Road Railroad Re-Alignment Project.

## <u>4906-11-02 (A) (2): Brief Description of Project</u>

American Transmission Systems, Incorporated's ("ATSI"), a FirstEnergy Corp. subsidiary, Eber-Swanton 138 kV Transmission line Relocation for the Hallett Road Railroad Re-Alignment Project ("Project") consists of removing four (4) existing transmission poles and replacing them with two (2) new wood poles and two (2) new laminated wood poles. The general location of the Project is shown in Exhibit 1, which is a partial copy of United States Geologic Survey, Fulton County, Ohio Quad, Map ID 41083-E8. The Project is located in the Village of Swanton, Fulton County and the Township of Swanton, Lucas County, Ohio.

The existing Eber-Swanton 138 kV Transmission Line runs perpendicular to Hallett Road in an east-to-west direction as it crosses Hallett Road, and is supported on wood poles in the area of the Project. The first two (2) poles of the transmission line on both the east and west side of Hallett Road will be replaced to accommodate the relocation of Hallett Road as part of the Hallett Road Railroad Re-Alignment project, as shown on Exhibit 2. In this Project, four (4) poles will be removed and replaced with two (2) laminated wood poles and two (2) wood poles, shown in Exhibits 3 and 4

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approximately five (5) feet from their current locations, as shown in the general layout Exhibit 2.

The proposed Project meets the requirements for a Construction Notice because the project is within the types of project defined by Item (9) of the Application Requirement Matrix for Electric Power Transmission Lines in Appendix A of 4906-1-01 of the Ohio Administrative Code, which requires the filing of a Construction Notice. This items states:

(9) Replacement or relocation of an electric power transmission line and associated facilities where the project is required by publicly funded entities and is located on or adjacent to right-of-way or land owned by the public entity requiring the project.

The existing poles are located within and the new poles will be located within the existing right of way of the transmission line which is adjacent to the right of way of Hallett Road. The existing Eber-Swanton 138 kV Transmission Line and the relocated poles will be owned by ATSI.

## 4906-11-02 (A) (3): Construction Schedule

Construction on the proposed Project is proposed to begin on August 1, 2008, and is expected to be completed by November 3, 2008.

## 4906-11-02 (A) (4): Estimated Costs

The estimated capital costs for the Project is \$150,000.

## 4906-11-02 (A) (5): Operating Characteristics

The existing Eber-Swanton 138 kV Transmission Line operates at 138 kV. The proposed relocation of four (4) poles will not change the operating characteristics of this transmission line. No new property rights are required for the proposed Project.

## <u>4906-11-02 (A) (6): Area Map</u>

Exhibit No. 1 depicts the general location of the project site. This exhibit provides a partial copy of the United States Geologic Survey, Fulton County, Ohio Quad, Map ID

41083-E8. To locate and view the project site from Columbus, Ohio, travel onto US-23 towards I-70 / I-71. Exit Interstate 70 at exit 93 onto I-270 towards Cleveland. At exit 17B travel onto US-33 for 17 miles towards OH-31 for approximately 30.3 miles. Turn onto SR-309, then immediately turn north onto US-68 for approximately 29.0 miles to I-75. At exit 192 turn onto I-475 towards US-23 Maumee for approximately 6.4 miles. At exit 6 turn right and travel towards Salisbury Road. Travel on Salisbury Road for approximately 0.7 miles. Turn left onto Strayer Road for approximately 0.7 miles, then turn right (west) onto Alt US-20 for approximately 4.8 miles. Turn right (north) onto CR-1 for approximately 0.6 miles. The project is located immediately to the north of the railroad tracks on Hallett Road.



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
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
