ENTRY

The Attorney Examiner, in carrying out the authority granted by Rule 4901-1-14, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), finds:

- (1) DIECA Communications, Inc. dba Covad Communications Company (Covad) was joined as a necessary party to this proceeding by an attorney examiner entry issued March 26, 2008. Further, as a necessary party to this proceeding, Covad was directed to file an answer or other responsive pleading to this complaint within 20 days after the issuance of March 26, 2008 entry.
- (2) On April 14, 2008, Covad filed a letter in this docket to request a one-week extension to file its answer or other responsive pleading in this proceeding. In support of its request, Covad submits that, as a recent addition to this proceeding, it would like additional time to investigate the circumstances surrounding this matter and to discuss potential settlement with the complainant.
- (3) The Attorney Examiner notes that the docket record for this case indicates that the March 26, 2008 entry was mailed to Covad on March 31, 2008. Accordingly, the Attorney Examiner finds that Covad's request for a one-week extension to file its answer or other responsive pleading is reasonable and should be granted.


It is, therefore,
