ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On April 8, 2008, Amos Press, Inc., (Amos) filed a complaint against Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc., (Vectren). The secretary of the Commission served that complaint on Vectren on the same day, requiring Vectren to file an answer no later than 20 days after the date of service.
- (2) On April 23, 2008, Vectren filed a motion for an extension of time to file its answer, such that the answer would be due on May 13, 2008. Vectren explains that the extension of the due date would allow the parties to continue their efforts to resolve the matter amicably. Vectren states that Amos has consented to the requested extension and to expedited treatment of the motion.
- (3) The examiner finds that it is reasonable to grant Vectren's motion. Vectren's answer will be due on May 13, 2008.

ORDERED, That Vectren's motion for an extension of time to file its answer be granted, as set forth in finding 3. It is, further,
