Subject: Risk to Ohio's Big Darby Creek, State and National Scenic River

Rockies Express Pipeline LLC is proposing the construction of a 42 inch natural gas line from Missouri through Ohio, crossing the Big Darby Creek.

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) has issued a draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), FERC Docket No. CP07-208-000.

Comments to the draft EIS submitted by the Ohio Power Siting Board clearly show the Board is opposed to the crossing of the Big Darby Creek and recommends using FERC's alternate route by-passing the Big Darby.

As your constituents, we strongly urge you to notify FERC that the OPSB's recommendation to use the Big Darby Creek Alternate Route be incorporated into the final EIS and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity scheduled to be issued on February 28, 2008.
