<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On February 13, 2008, Donald Parrish filed a complaint stating that the repair of a gas leak at his residence was the responsibility of Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia) and that he unnecessarily expended funds to repair the leak.
- (2) On May 2, 2008, Columbia filed a motion to dismiss the complaint stating that the parties have resolved all the issues raised in the complaint. Columbia stated that, since nothing more remains to be done, the complaint should be dismissed as a settled case.
- (3) Rule 4901-9-01(F), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that, if the public utility complained against files a motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response to Columbia's motion has been filed. Accordingly, Columbia's motion to dismiss should be granted and this case should be closed of record.

ORDERED, That Columbia's motion to dismiss is granted and this case be dismissed. It is, further,
