- C. A customer may choose to subscribe to ISDN Single Line Service from a central office other than his normal serving central office. In this situation, the customer will utilize the dialing plan associated with the central office that delivers the dial tone. Where available, rates and charges will be provided as shown in the Company's Tariffs.

- F. Directory Listings will be furnished subject to the rates and regulations specified in Section 4 of this Tariff.
- G. Regulations specified in Section 1 are applicable to ISDN Single Line Service unless otherwise specified elsewhere in this Section.

- H. A single primary directory number (DN) is included with ISDN Single Line Service. Secondary directory numbers may be purchased as provided in Paragraph 4.06, of this Section. A shared Primary DN is a primary DN that appears on more than one terminal. A shared Secondary DN is a DN that appears on more than one terminal but is not the primary DN on any of those terminals. A Secondary DN may function as a primary DN on a terminal within a business group.
