

Now comes The Neighborhood Environmental Coalition (hereinafter “Coalition”), The Consumers for Fair Utility Rates (hereinafter “Consumers”), The Cleveland Housing Network (hereinafter “Network”), and The Empowerment Center of Greater Cleveland (hereinafter “Center”) who, through their counsel, hereby file Their List of Main Issues in the above-captioned matters pursuant to Ohio Law, The Rules and Regulations pertaining to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, the orders of the Hearing Examiners in this case, and the relevant case law. All four of the interveners are hereinafter referred to as “The Citizens Coalition.”

Their List of Main Issues are Numbered and Provided below.

1. DSM and Weatherization Programs: While the PUCO Staff and Company have very properly and responsibly proposed and recommended funding for those much needed programs, the amount recommended is far below what is required and would benefit all customers. The amount proposed is \$5.27 million which is a fairly minor increase over the Company’s current program. The Citizens Coalition strongly


recommends that these programs should be funded at the level of \$25 million a year with \$5 million of this coming from stockholders.

2. **Customer Charge:** The Staff has proposed a monstrous 300% jump in the customer charge. This will most significantly impact low-income families as well as families who try to conserve. The Citizens Coalition strongly recommends that the entire customer charge should be eliminated.

3. **Decoupling:** The Staff and Company are proposing a decoupling scheme. This is little more than statistical manipulation and accounting tricks, recalling the machinations of Enron in its utility dealings. No decoupling should be allowed to the Company.

4. **Rate of Return:** The Staff has proposed a rate of return at the very top of its range of what it considers appropriate. Rather than adopting this inflated figure, a more reasonable rate of return either in the middle or toward the bottom of the Staff's range should be adopted.


