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SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, CONT'D.

2.12 Taxes and Fees

The Company shall charge the Customer an amount sufficient to recover any governmental assessments, fees, license, or other similar taxes or fees imposed upon the Company.

For all services offered by the Company, taxes and fees shall be added pro-rate, insofar as practical, to the rates and charges stated in the Company's rate schedules and listed as separate line items on the Customer's bill for services provided.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

3.1 General

Each Customer is charged individually for each call placed through the Company.

Charges may vary by service offering, mileage band, class of call, time of day, day of week, call duration, and/or volume and term commitment.

Customers are billed based on their use of the Company's long distance service.

3.2 Calculation of Distance

Usage charges for mileage sensitive products are based on the airline distance between the Rate Centers associated with the originating and terminating points of the call.

The distance between the originating and terminating points is calculated by using the "V" and "H" coordinates of the serving wire centers as defined by BellCore (Bell Communications Research), in the following manner:

Step 1:	Obtain the "V" and "H" coordinates for the Rate Center of the originating and the destination points.
Step 2:	Obtain the difference between the "V" coordinates of each of he Rate Centers. Obtain the difference between the "H" coordinated.
Step 3:	Square the differences obtained in Step 2.
Step 4:	Add the squares of the "V" difference and "H" difference obtained in Step 3.
Step 5:	Divide the sum of the square obtained in Step 4 by ten (10). Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction results from the division.
Step 6:	Obtain the square root of the whole number obtained in Step 5. Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction is obtained. This is the distance between the originating and terminating locations of the call.

3.3 Timing of Calls

- **3.3.1** Long distance usage charges are based on the actual usage of the Company's network. Chargeable time begins when a connection is established between the calling station and the called station. Chargeable time ends when either party "hangs up" thereby releasing the network connection.
- **3.3.2** Unless otherwise specified in this tariff the minimum call duration and rounding of calls for measurement and billing purposes is one minute.

3.4 Time-of-Day Rate Periods

Unless otherwise indicated elsewhere in this tariff, all usage-based rates in this tariff are subject to the following time-of-day, day-of-week, and holiday rate periods:

- **3.4.1** Day Rate Period Applies to that portion of a call occurring from 8:00 AM to, but not including, 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.
- **3.4.2** Evening Rate Period Applies to that portion of a call occurring from 5:00 PM to, but not including, 11:00 PM all days, unless a lower rate would normally apply.
- 3.4.3 Night and Weekend Rate Period Applies to that portion of a call occurring from 11:00 PM to, but not including 8:00 the following morning, all days; all day on Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 AM to, but not including 5:00 PM.
- **3.4.4** When a call is established in one rate period and ends in another rate period, the rate in effect at the calling station applies to the portion of the call occurring within that rate period. When a unit of time is split between two rate periods, the rate applicable to that unit of time is based on the rate period in which it began.

3.5 **Holiday Rates**

Holiday Rates apply to that portion of a call occurring on Company acknowledged Holidays. The rate is equivalent to the Evening Rate unless a lower rate would normally apply. Holiday rates apply on New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Memorial day, July 4th Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Evening Rate Period rates will apply to all calls made from 8:00 AM to, but not including, 11:00 PM on Company-recognized holidays.

3.6 **Directory Assistance**

A Directory Assistance charge applies per intrastate directory assistance calls made from points within the State of Ohio. The Customer may make two requests for a telephone number per call. The Directory Assistance Charge applies regardless of whether the operator is able to supply the requested number. Discounts are not applicable to Directory Assistance Charges. Directory Assistance Charges are not included in usage commitments or computed in any discount calculations. . . . - -

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE, CONT'D.

3.8 Public Pay Telephone Surcharge

In order to recover the Company's expenses to comply with the FCC's pay telephone compensation plan effective on October 7, 1997 (FCC 97-371), an undiscountable per call charge is applicable to all interstate, intrastate and international calls that originate from any domestic pay telephone used to access the Company's services. This surcharge, which is in addition to standard tariffed usage charges and any applicable service charges and surcharges associated with the Company's service, applies for the use of the instrument used to access the Company service and is unrelated to the Company's service accessed from the pay telephone.

Pay telephones include coin-operated and coinless phones owned by local telephone companies, independent companies and other interexchange carriers. The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge applies to the initial completed call and any reoriginated call (i.e., using the "#" symbol).

Whenever possible, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge will appear on the same invoice containing the usage charges for the surcharged call. In cases where proper pay telephone coding digits are not transmitted to the Company prior to completion of a call, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge may be billed on a subsequent invoice after the Company has obtained information from a carrier that the originating station is an eligible pay telephone.

The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge does not apply to calls placed from pay telephones at which the Customer pays for service by inserting coins during the progress of the call.

The Low Volume rate applies to accounts with total monthly Public Pay Telephone Surcharge billing which is equal to or less than \$100. The High Volume rate applies to accounts with monthly Public Pay Telephone Surcharge billing greater than \$100 (when rated at \$0.75 per call).

2.4 Taxes and Surcharges

- 2.4.1 All state and local taxes (i.e., gross receipts tax, sales tax, municipal utilities tax) are listed as separate line items and are not included in the quoted rates.
- 2.4.2 Surcharges (i.e., 911, subscriber line charge, etc.) approved or mandated by any governmental jurisdiction are listed separately on the bill and are not included in quoted rates.

2.5 Terminal Equipment

The Company's service may be used with or terminated in Customer-provided terminal equipment or Customer-provided communications systems, such as a telephone set, key system or private branch exchange (PBX). Such terminal equipment shall be furnished and maintained at the expense of the Customer, except as otherwise provided. The Customer is responsible for all costs at his or her premises, including personnel, wiring, electrical power, and the like, incurred in the use of the Company's service. When such terminal equipment is used, the equipment shall comply with the generally accepted minimum protective criteria standards of the telecommunications industry as endorsed by the Federal Communications Commission.

2.6 Installation

Service is installed upon mutual agreement between the Customer and the Company. The service agreement does not alter rates specified in this tariff.

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2.8 **Deposits and Advance Payments**

Each service applicant will be required to establish credit. Any applicant whose credit has not been duly established to the sole and exclusive satisfaction of the Company may be required to make a deposit to be held as a guarantee of payment of charges at the time of application. In addition, an existing customer may be required to make a deposit or increase a deposit presently held.

- 2.8.1 A deposit is not to exceed the estimated charges for two (2) months' service plus 30% of the estimated monthly charge. Deposits will be held for a period of one year. Interest on intrastate deposits will be in accordance with Rule 4901:1-17-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code.
- A deposit will be returned... 2.8.2

...When an application for service has been canceled prior to the establishment of service. The deposit will be applied to any charges applicable in accordance with the tariff and the excess portion of the deposit will be returned.

... Upon the discontinuance of service. The Company will refund the Subscriber's deposit or the balance in excess of unpaid bills for that service. At the option of the Company, such a deposit may be refunded or credited to the Subscriber at any time prior to the termination of the service.

- 2.8.3 The fact that a deposit has been made in no way relieves the Subscriber from complying with the regulation with respect to advance payments and the prompt payment of bills on presentation.

2.11.14 Discontinuance of Service other than Toll Service

- For purposes of this section, all regulated telephone services provided by the Α. Company, except toll services, shall be defined as local service.
- The Company may disconnect its customer's local service for nonpayment of Β. charges incurred for local service. Such disconnection must be conducted pursuant to all applicable minimum telephone service standards. All practices of the Company pertaining to either the provision of its own toll service, if any, or as a duly-authorized agent for another toll service provider shall also conform to the minimum telephone service standards.
