Re: Rockies Express; draft Water Monitoring Plan

Dear Mr. McKiernan:

This letter is to confirm that on June 3, 2008 you mailed to my office a copy of a draft Water Monitoring Plan which I received on June 4. In its accompanying cover letter you stated that this draft "is being provided for review and comment by your client, Hoosier Hills Regional Water District, in accordance with Environmental Condition #57" of the FEIS. You further stated that you "will need to receive any comments that your client wishes to make on the enclosed draft Water Monitoring Plan no later than the close of business on Monday, June 9, 2008 in order to allow appropriate time for consideration of the comments and possibly reflecting them in the final Water Monitoring Plan submitted to FERC."

We are currently reviewing the plan and compiling our collective concerns with the draft Water Monitoring Plan; however, the short deadline you have unilaterally imposed is obviously impossible to meet. My clients will require additional time in order to achieve a full and proper analysis of the proposed Plan, to identify all areas of concern, and to consider and prepare alternatives to propose.

We believe this approach is far more in line with Environmental Condition #57, which, as you know, requires REX to develop the water quality testing plan in consultation with Hoosier Hills. Your stated approach merely to "receive" and "consider" comments with

only "possibly reflecting them in the final Water Monitoring Plan submitted to FERC" falls short of developing the plan in consultation with Hoosier Hills and does not meet with the letter or spirit of Condition #57.

I am currently in trial in Utah, and expect it to conclude by July 11. In my absence, my associate will make every reasonable effort to assist Hoosier Hills with expediting their completion of its analysis and proposed alternatives. My office will forward our response to you as soon as possible; however, we ask that you kindly allow until July 14 for these efforts to be completed. Once you receive our response, we can arrange a meeting of all appropriate individuals to discuss our mutual positions so that true consultation can be achieved.
