9	Exhibit 1 which is the report by the staff of the
10	Public Utilities Commission of Ohio in the matter of
11	Constitution Gas Transport Co., Inc., it was docketed
12	on April 29th of 2008 and I've already given copies
13	of that to your Honor and the court reporter.

your leave I'd like to -- I also lost my pen in the process somewhere, so I'd like to correct that on here if I could. I'll give the original to the reporter. 4 5 THE EXAMINER: It will be so marked as corrected. 7 (EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.) THE EXAMINER: And I assume you have no 8 objections. MS. HAMMERSTEIN: No objections. 10 11 THE EXAMINER: It will be admitted. (EXHIBIT ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.) 12 THE EXAMINER: Is there anything further? 13 14 MR. ROYER: Yes, your Honor.
