ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) By entry of July 2, 2008, the Commission requested that interested persons file comments on proposed changes to the Commission's rules governing the transportation of household goods, Chapter 4901:2-19, Ohio Administrative Code. Pursuant to the entry, initial comments were directed to be filed by July 21, 2008, and reply comments were directed to be filed by July 28, 2008.
- (2) On July 8, 2008, the Ohio Association of Movers, Inc. (OAM) filed a request to extend the comment period until September 5, 2008. OAM stated that it did not receive a copy of the July 2, 2008, Commission entry until July 7, 2008. OAM also indicated that its membership consists of approximately 155 registered movers and that the time up to September 5, 2008, is the movers "busy season". OAM asserts that an extension to file comments until September 5, 2008, would not cause undue hardship as the present rules were last reviewed and effective May 31, 2001.
- (3) Upon review, the attorney examiner will grant OAM's request. Accordingly, initial comments to the proposed revisions to the rules should now be filed by September 5, and reply comments should now be filed by September 12, 2008.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the date for filing initial comments be extended to September 5, 2008, and reply comments by September 12, 2008. It is, further,
