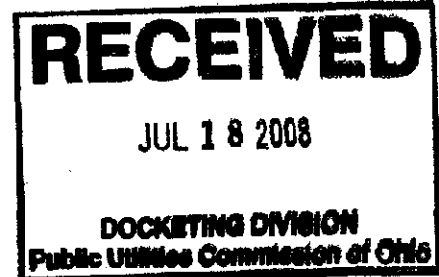

Ms. Bose:

On June 10, 2008, Rockies Express Pipeline LLC (“Rockies Express”) filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC” or “Commission”) a request for Notice to Proceed (“NTP”) to commence construction on Spread A-1 of its Rockies Express Pipeline-East (“REX-East”) Project. In its June 10 NTP request, Rockies Express identified several areas where agency clearance or concurrence had not yet been completed, and, as a result, where Rockies Express proposed to use either an exclusion zone or a restricted travel lane to avoid “non-cleared” areas. The areas where SHPO concurrence was pending and the related exclusion zones and restricted travel lanes were set forth in Table 2-4.

On June 23, July 2, and July 3, respectively, Rockies Express filed supplemental cultural data with respect to Spread A-1, including cultural resources survey reports and the related State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) correspondence and concurrences to the reports.<sup>1</sup> As a result of these latter SHPO concurrences, Table 2-4 of the June 10 NTP request for Spread A-1 has been revised.

Accordingly, attached for filing is an updated Table 2-4 that eliminates several exclusion areas and restricted travel lanes that are no longer applicable due to SHPO clearances. Additionally, the supporting tables for Table 2-4, Tables 4.1.3-1 and 4.1.3-2, also are attached, with corresponding revisions. Table 4.1.3-2 contains sensitive cultural information, and, therefore, is filed as privileged and confidential in accordance with the Commission’s regulations.

Thank you for submitting information on the above referenced project for our review pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (P.L. 89-665, as amended) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's regulation 36 CFR Part 800, which require identification and evaluation of cultural resources.

We have reviewed the June 2008 report entitled *Third Phase II Archaeological Site Assessment in the Northeastern Missouri Segment of the Proposed Rockies Express Pipeline-East (REX-East) Project Corridor, Audrain, Ralls, and Pike Counties, Missouri* by the University of Iowa Office of the State Archaeologist. Based on this review, it is evident that a thorough and adequate testing program has been conducted. We concur with the investigator's recommendation that archaeological sites 23PI1344 and 23PI1337 are eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places:


If at all possible, the proposed project should be designed to avoid 23PI1344 and 23PI1337. Plans detailing the redesign of the project corridor should be submitted to this office in order to document the successful avoidance. If avoidance is not feasible, there will be an **adverse effect** on these sites. In this event, a Data Recovery Plan should be developed in consultation with interested parties, and a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) should be developed in consultation with interested parties.

We also concur that archaeological sites 23PI1317, 23PI1342, 23PI1345, 23PI1346 and 23PI1347 are not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places.
