To the staff of the Commission,

In response to request for comments to Case No. 08-599-TR-ORD, I am not opposed with the proposed rule review. Please note, in my opinion, these are not subtle changes or adjustments. These are wholesale changes that alter the legislative intent of 4901:2-19 and Senate Bill 32. It is also my opinion that the Commission would best serve the needs of our State and its citizens by a slower more careful review with opinions from all sides of this issue, i.e. PUCO, Ohio General Assembly, Consumer Groups and The Ohio Association of Movers.

Page 2 of the Entry – Paragraph 4

Commission should prescribe or give approval of all forms required by Carriers. See forms previously approved by the PUCO and are currently provided by the Ohio Association of Movers, Inc.

4901:2-19-02-General Provisions

(B) Pursuant to its jurisdiction under Title 49 of the Revised Code and **upon notice to all interested parties with time to comment**, the commission may:

(F) The July 2, 2008 – **date should be the same day the new rules are effective.**

4901:2-19-03 – Tariffs and rates

(D) All carriers are liable for the **declared value of goods....**

(F) All tariffs shall include a title page **showing name of carrier, address and PUCO Certificate NO.,** consistent with the

(M) **ADD – Tariffs to be posted on PUCO website by the effective date.** This needs to be accessible for a consumer verification of rates.

4901:2-19-04 – Changes to tariffs

(A) Change to: **Tariff changes will be effective 10 days from the date received by the PUCO.** The PUCO has active supervision of rate changes and needs time to post on their website for verification by the consumer.

(E) By using discounting and special contracts indicates discrimination to other consumers not meeting the criteria of the contract. Delete this item and see the recommended amended 4901:2-19-16 – Prohibitions.

4901:2-19-08 – Estimates by the carrier

(G) Maintain the use of the "Moving in Ohio" brochure, prescribed by the PUCO.

4901:2-19-16 – Prohibitions


(B) Should read: **Commission shall establish customer complain procedures that comply with all of the following requirements:**

(C) Discounts put all of us on a very slippery slope. Please use caution with the term REASONABLE. Discounts, in the end, will only benefit large companies. They have the volume of business to dictate price. Discrimination will happen regardless of intent.

I also believe the Commission should have an internal review of enforcement policies. We still have unlicensed movers, advertising and operating for 5 years without being stopped.
