To the staff of the Commission,

In response to request for comments to Case No. 08-599-TR-ORD, I am opposed to some of the proposed rule changes and I agree with others. I would like to give you a list of those that I object to.

Page 2 of the Entry Paragraph 4

Commission should prescribe or give approval of all forms required by Carriers. We all ready have in effect approved forms by PUCO which are currently provided by the Ohio Association of Movers.

General provisions

(B) There should be consideration for notice to be given to all interested parties with time to comment.

(F) Date should be the same say the new rules are effective.

(D) Carriers are only liable for DECLARED value of goods....

(E) Relating to INTERSTATE traffic ONLY

(F) All tariffs shall include a title page with the name of Carrier, address and PUCO Certificate Number.

(M) Tariffs to be posted on PUCO website by the effective date.

Changes to tariffs

(A) Tariff changes need to be supervised by the PUCO and should be posted on the PUCO website. With this in mind all changes should be effective in 10 days.

(D) Interstate carriers do not have hourly rates. Could you explain this ruling?

(E) By using discounting and special contracts indicates discrimination to other consumers not meeting criteria of the contract. This item should be deleted.

(G) Maintain the use of the "Moving in Ohio" brochure, prescribed by the PUCO
