I read with dismay the planned increase in the flat rate. There is no way that these amounts can be paid. Our agencies and groups do not have the funds to help the huge amount of people that will need help to keep a roof over them this winter, and heating will be impossible. If we can't heat our homes, pipes will burst, homes will be bandoned.

I work and earn around \$27000 or a little more per year. From that I must pay mortgage, water, electric, heating and drying gas, insurances, and feed and cloth my family of 6. Gasoline prices have gone through the roof and so just to get to work I must cut into things like clothing for the children. We do not have a land line telephone; we do not have cable television. We do have a good work ethic and want to survive.

If I do not pay the water-it will be turned off and we will have to leave our home as it is illegal to stay in a home without running water. If we do not pay electric, we cannot ignite the stove or furnace and dryer. If we do not pay insurance, I cannot drive to work or keep my house and my family in my house. These are realities.

The need to put so many people into the streets with no means of helping them is not a need. It is simple corporate greed. Even my retirement fund is suffering from our country's situation, would it not be prudent to protect the customer base instead of destroying it through poorly thought out proposals? The cost of living is beyond the means of many of us already. One more thing and many of us will be done for.

Yes, there will be the few that get richer through workers suffering. Please do not allow this. There aren't places for us to go--.

With regard to the proposed rate increase by Dominion East Ohio, I must oppose in the strongest possible terms the proposals as presently requested. At a time when all or almost all living expenses are reaching increasingly impossible figures, we are facing choices about basic needs and services many people find more than painful.

As a senior retired individual, I find myself facing more and more problems maintaining myself and my home, as I am sure many of Ohio's citizens are. If Dominion East Ohio desires replacing their pipeline infrastructure, then so far as I am concerned this is one of their costs of doing business, and while their customers could possibly expect a small increase in their bills to assist in the cost of this plan, there is no justification in my view for bearing the major burden of such a program. If this is not the case, then Dominion East Ohio should disclose the ultimate total cost of the project to avoid suspicion that the customer is not being railroaded for a disproportional share of the project. The same should be said for the meter reading device program.

I would hope that the customers of Dominion East Ohio will voice their opposition to this proposal in the strongest possible terms, not only to the commission, but to their elected representatives and the Governor's office. I certainly intend to do so. From past experience with the PUCO has shown in all too many instances, your commission has tended to largely ignore the public's best interests in utility rate cases, and I can only hope that this huge increase coming at a distressed time will not add to this impression.
