## <u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On September 21, 2007, the complainant, CRS Enterprises of Michigan, Inc. dba Help U Finance.com, filed a complaint in this case against the respondent, Lightyear Network Solutions, LLC (Lightyear). The complaint alleges that the respondent slammed the complainant's toll-free numbers and continued to demand that the complainant pay for service once the slamming occurred.
- (2) On October 12, 2007, the respondent, through its supervisor for legal/regulatory affairs, filed a written response to the complaint. In its response, Lightyear maintains that no slamming occurred and further claims that it is owed a balance in excess of \$4,000.00 for services rendered.
- (3) On March 12, 2008, the attorney examiner contacted the complainant by telephone to discuss the scheduling of a settlement conference. The complainant informed the attorney examiner that a resolution of the case had already been achieved as between the complainant and the respondent and that the complainant did not wish to pursue further prosecution of this case. At the attorney examiner's request, the complainant agreed during the phone call to file a letter in the docket formally seeking to have the Commission close the case. However, to date, no such letter has been filed in this case.

(4) It appears, based on the complainant's telephone conversation with the attorney examiner, that this matter has now been resolved between the parties of record in this case and that, as a result, the complainant no longer wishes to proceed further in the prosecution of this case. Therefore, the Commission finds it appropriate to dismiss this case, effective September 10, 2008, unless the complainant files a letter in this docket, by no later than September 10, 2008, requesting that this case remain open, and indicating the complainant's intention to proceed immediately in the further prosecution of its complaint in this case. In the event that such a letter is filed, the attorney examiner will act expeditiously to schedule a prehearing settlement conference to occur in this case.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case is hereby dismissed effective September 10, 2008, subject to the contingencies set out in Finding (4), above. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
