Ms. Bose:

As agreed upon in the Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") that was filed on, July 2, 2008, Rockies Express has previously submitted Treatment Plan 3 for sites that cannot be avoided by construction to the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency ("SHPO" or "IHPA"). Rockies Express received comment from the SHPO on September 5, 2008 concurring with Treatment Plan 3 (Attachment A).

Rockies Express requests approval to commence immediately its data recoveries at the archeological sites referenced in the Illinois Treatment Plan 3 (IHPA Log Number 004051506). The sites are 11PK1791/1792, 11PK1759, 11ST540/541, 11E151 and 11DO201. Rockies Express intends to implement the treatment approaches outlined in its Illinois Treatment Plan 3 for the previously identified sites.



We are in receipt of Illinois Treatment Plan No. 3; Pike, Scott, and Douglas Counties; Illinois Rockies Express Pipeline-East (REX-East) Project submitted on your behalf by Commonwealth Cultural Resources Group, Inc. It is understood that archaeological site 11PK1664 will be avoided by the proposed pipeline through a re-route and that the proposed undertaking will have no effect on these sites.
