Neighborhood Select service in service on October 15, 2008 will be continued in service only for as long as such service remains at the location at which service is being furnished on the aforementioned date. In the event that these services are discontinued at their present location for any reason, they will not be re-established.

#### A. Description

Neighborhood Select is a one-way optional calling plan. Neighborhood Select permits customers to expand their calling area by adding one or more exchanges from those available in the plan. The plan's additional exchanges consist of contiguous exchange(s), the exchange of the County Seat, and exchange(s) of school districts which are not included in the customer's local calling area. Neighborhood Select provides for calling on a flat rate basis from the customer's exchange to the exchange(s) selected by the customer.

- 1. Neighborhood Select is a pilot plan that is available to residence customers. Service will commence on the effective date of this tariff. It will be offered for not less than 12 months, at which time it may be extended, modified, or withdrawn by the Company.
