ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (Dominion) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) In our Opinion and Order dated October 15, 2008, the Commission approved the joint stipulation filed on August 22, 2008, as modified

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in the opinion and order, and approved Dominion's revised tariffs, consistent with the discussion and findings set forth in that Opinion and Order.

- (3) On October 21, 2008, Dominion filed an application to revise its bill format to reflect changes made to the back of its bill to incorporate and describe certain items and changes approved in the Opinion and Order.
- (4) In its application, Dominion requested expedited treatment of this motion, in order to reduce the already significant lead time required in ordering new billing stock, arguing that, without expedited treatment, it may run out of its current bill stock and be required to order additional stock of the current bill format.
- (5) On October 24, 2008, Dominion filed an amended application to include in its bill format the revised instructions for contacting the Commission and the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, as approved in Case No. 07-1042-AU-ORD.
- (6) The Commission finds that the amended bill format submitted by Dominion is reasonable and that it should be approved.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the amended bill format filed on October 24, 2008, be approved.
It is, further,



ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.




