ENTRY NUNC PRO TUNC

The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 5, 2008, the Commission issued a finding and order that modified Rule 4901:1-5-10, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), and directed that copies of the modified rule be filed with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review, the Secretary of State, and the Legislative Service Commission in accordance with divisions (D) and (E) of Section 111.15, Revised Code.
- (2) The Commission has discovered that there was an error in the first sentence of paragraph (C) of the revised rule set forth in the appendix of the November 5, 2008, finding and order. Specifically, the first sentence of paragraph (C) of Rule 4901:1-5-10, O.A.C., should have read:

If a customer is disconnected for nonpayment of past due charges, the incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC) shall, upon request, reconnect the customer to stand-alone basic local exchange service (BLES) upon the customer's payment of an amount sufficient to cover the ILEC's tariffed rate for stand-alone BLES service, all associated taxes and government mandated surcharges (i.e., universal service fund and 9-1-1 service charges), and any applicable deposit and reconnection fee, and upon the customer entering into a payment arrangement for all unpaid regulated charges.

The Commission determines that the first sentence of paragraph (C) found in the appendix of the November 5, 2008, finding and order should be amended by revising the sentence as set forth above. In all other respects, the November 5, 2008, finding and order shall remain in full force and effect.
