

#### Dear Ohio-American Customer:

On October 12, 2007, the Ohio-American Water Company (Company) filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) a notice of its intent to seek an increase in rates in Case No. 07-1112-WS-AIR. After extensive discussions and negotiations, the Company, Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, the City of Marion, a commercial customer, and the staff of the PUCO submitted a joint stipulation and recommendation to the PUCO. Local public hearings were held in Mansfield, Marion, Blendon Township and Prairie Township, Ohio. The Commission approved the new rates on November 12, 2008. The Company will be implementing new rates on a bills rendered basis effective on November 13, 2008. The new water and wastewater rates represent an overall total revenue increase of approximately \$5,264,697, which equates to 15.81% over the rates that have been in effect since March 7, 2007. The factors contributing to the increase were costs associated with an increase investment in new plant, and increases in pension expense, state, local and federal taxes, and general operating expenses.

Your rates are based on water and/or a wastewater charge combined with a monthly service charge. Both of these rates have changed as shown below. The effects of these combined charges are displayed in the bottom chart, showing the average combined bills for each service territory and type of customer.

The softening surcharge will be changed to \$0.6007 per ccf, from \$0.6122, a decrease of \$0.0115. The reverse osmosis surcharge will be changed from \$1.3250 to \$1.1922 per ccf, a decrease of \$0.1328. The account activation charge will remain unchanged at \$23.10 for new service establishment during the Company's regular business hours. The fire service charges will be changed from \$0.83 to \$1.01, an increase of \$0.18. The purchased water adjustment surcharge will be eliminated. The dishonored payment charge will be changed from \$20.75 to \$17.25, a decrease of \$3.50.
