ENTRY ON REHEARING

The Commission finds:


- (1) On April 21, 2008, Intrado Communications, Inc. (Intrado) filed a petition for arbitration of six issues to establish an interconnection agreement with Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company (CBT). Intrado filed the petition pursuant to Section 252(b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- (2) On October 8, 2008, the Commission issued its arbitration award in this proceeding.
- (3) Section 4903.10, Revised Code, indicates that any party who has entered an appearance in a Commission proceeding may apply for rehearing with respect to any matters determined by filing an application within 30 days after the entry of the order upon the journal of the Commission.
- (4) On November 7, 2008, Intrado and CBT filed applications for rehearing of the Commission's arbitration award.
- (5) On November 17, 2008, Intrado and CBT filed memoranda opposing each other's application for rehearing.
- (6) The Commission grants the applications for rehearing filed by Intrado and CBT. Intrado and CBT have set forth sufficient reasons to warrant further consideration of the issues raised in the applications for rehearing.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the applications for rehearing filed by Intrado and CBT are granted for further consideration of the matters specified therein. It is, further,

ORDERED, That copies of this entry on rehearing be served upon the parties, their respective counsel, and upon all interested persons of record.


