MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT
OF
MOTION FOR EXTENSION

CERTIFICATE EXPIRATION DATE

World Energy Solutions, Inc. ("World Energy") is a Commission-certified aggregator/broker for competitive retail natural gas service ("CRNGS") in this state. World Energy's current certificate, Ohio Competitive Retail Natural Gas Aggregator/Broker Certificate No. 06-121 (1), is effective through December 17, 2008. Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-27-09 (A) Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC"), certification renewal applications must be filed no less than thirty (30) days and no more that one hundred twenty (120) days prior to the certificate expiration date. Thus, World Energy's renewal application was due on November 17, 2008. However, due to a misunderstanding on World Energy's part regarding the determination of the due date, World Energy sent its renewal application on December 10, 2008, and the renewal application was not received by the Commission and docketed until December 12, 2008.

On December 26, 2008, World Energy received a "PUCO Notice of Probable Non-Compliance" advising that, unless World Energy formally petitioned the Commission to extend its expired operating authority, the Commission would have no option other than to initiate escalated enforcement action that may include civil forfeitures. Accordingly, by the forgoing motion, World Energy requests that the expiration date of its current certificate be extended from December 17, 2008 to January 12, 2009 to take into account the thirty (30) day requirement. World Energy apologizes for the inconvenience caused by its failure to file tie renewal application in a timely manner.

WHEREFORE, World Energy Solutions, Inc. respectfully requests that its motion be granted.
